

Access by Bus (Bus fair: 220 yen)

Check the destination before you get on a bus. Buses going opposite directions have a same number.

From Imadegawa (Subway Karasuma Line K06) (approx. 10-15min.)

Take Exit 3 from Subway South Ticket Gate



bound for Gion·Hyakumanben(祗園·百万遍) and Shijo Omiya (四条大宮) Karasuma Imadegawa → Hyakumanben or Kyodai Seimon-mae (烏丸今出川)

[City Bus # 203]

bound for Ginkakuji (銀閣寺道・錦林車庫)

Karasuma Imadegawa → Hyakumanben

From Shijo Karasuma (approx. 25-35min.) [City Bus # 201]

bound for **Gion·Hyakumanben** (祗園·百万遍)

Shijo Karasuma → Kyodai Seimon-mae (四条烏丸)



From Kyoto JR Station (approx. 30-40min.)

[City Bus # 206] from Bus Platform D2 bound for **Kitaoji Bus Terminal via Higashiyama St. (東山通 北大路バスターミナル**) Kyoto Station → Kyodai Seimon-mae

[City Bus # 17] from Bus Platform A2 bound for Ginkakuji (銀閣寺道・錦林車庫) Kyoto Station → Hyakumanben

From Shijo Karasuma and Kyoto Station, you can also take Subway to K06 and transfer to a bus at Imadegawa (to avoid overcrowded buses).

How to ride on a bus: (1) Enter the bus from the back door. (2) Prepare 220yen (inner-city area has flat rate) beforehand or in the bus. Change for coins (e.g., 500yen) and 1000yen bills can be made by the machine at the front of the bus.

- (3) When the name of your destination is announced, press the button to stop the bus at the next bus stop.
- (4) Pay at the front when you exit (drop your fare into the payment box).
