Space Assignments

Demo space will be assigned based on the date the application is received. Demo space assignments will be mailed or e-mailed by September 18, 2011.

Space Selections

The Demo Presenter agrees to accept the space assigned. The ICCV 2011 organization (further designated as the Conference) reserves the right to modify the designated demo space in the event a change in the original assignment is necessary.

Acceptance of Demo

The acceptance of a demo presentation requires that at least one of the presenters will register at the conference by September 30th. The rest of presenters may register later at extra cost. Please, send a copy of the registration to demo@iccv2011.org. If no registration is received by this date, organizers will understand that presenters withdraw the demo application.

Demos - What is Included?

The Conference will furnish a table of suitable size, two chairs, an electric outlet with 220V and European plug (bring your current adapters!!), and internet access.

Violations

Insurance
